
Call for Artists

work will be accepted. Each educator can submit **three works** that have been completed within the last two years. Artwork may be dropped off Friday, January 25, 2019 from 11am to 5pm, Saturday, January 26, 2019 from 10am to 4pm, or Tuesday, January

29, 2019 from 11am to 5pm.

The Exhibit will run from January 31, 2019 through February 26, 2019. An opening reception will be held on Thursday, January 31, 2018 from 5pm to 7pm.

The Washington County Arts Council 34 South Potomac Street, Suite 100 Hagerstown, MD 21740.

All entries are to be received by WCAC no later than 5pm on January 29, 2019.

Liability:

Once received by WCAC, all artwork will be insured for 70% of its retail value as indicated on the gallery inventory list until it has been sold or returned to the artist. All work must be available for sale. The WCAC, a non-profit agency, retains a 30% commission on all works sold during the exhibit.

The WCAC is not responsible for damage resulting from poor workmanship, defects or lack of quality control by the artist.

Conditions:

Hanging works should be properly wired with eye hooks placed approximately 1/3 from the top of the work and framing wire of appropriate weight should be used (no saw tooth hangers, please). Hanging specifications can be found online at: https://www.washingtoncountyarts.com/files /Procedures/Hanging%20Specifications%20 Updated%202018-07-11.pdf. All work must be labeled on the back with artist name, school, title, and price.

WCAC will not exhibit any work that is presented in an unprofessional manner and reserves the right of final review on all work once it has been delivered.

Work cannot be withdrawn before the end of the exhibit.

All work must be retrieved from WCAC between 3pm and 5pm on Tuesday, February 26, 2019.
