

Call for Artists



The Washington County Arts Council invites all art educators in Washington County's public and private schools to enter work for the February exhibit. This is an invitational exhibition and all work will be accepted. Each educator is allowed to submit **three works** that have been completed within the last two years. Artwork may be dropped off Friday, January 27, 2017 from 11am to 5pm, Saturday, January 28, 2017 from 10am to 4pm, Tuesday, January 31, 2017 from 11am to 5pm or Wednesday, February 1, 2017 from 11am to 5pm.

The Exhibit will run from February 3, 2017 through February 28, 2017. An opening reception will be held on Friday, February 3, 2017 from 5pm to 7pm.

All entries are to be received by the WCAC no later than 5pm on February 1, 2017.

Liability:

Once received by the WCAC, all artwork will be insured for 70% of its retail value as indicated on

the gallery inventory list until it has been sold or returned to the artist.

All work must be available for sale. The WCAC, a non-profit agency, retains a 30% commission on all works sold during the exhibit.

The WCAC is not responsible for damage resulting from poor workmanship, defects or lack of quality control by the artist.

Conditions:

Hanging works should be properly wired with eye hooks placed approximately 1/3 from the top of the work and framing wire of appropriate weight should be used (no saw tooth hangers, please). All work must be labeled on the back with artist name, school, title, and price.

The WCAC will not exhibit any work that is presented in an unprofessional manner and reserves the right of final review on all work once it has been delivered.

Work cannot be withdrawn before the end of the exhibit.

All work must be retrieved from the WCAC between 11am and 5pm on Wednesday, March 1, 2017.
