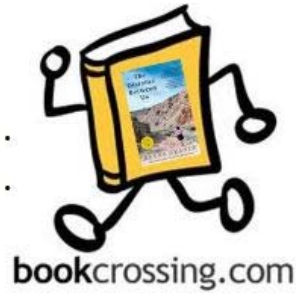
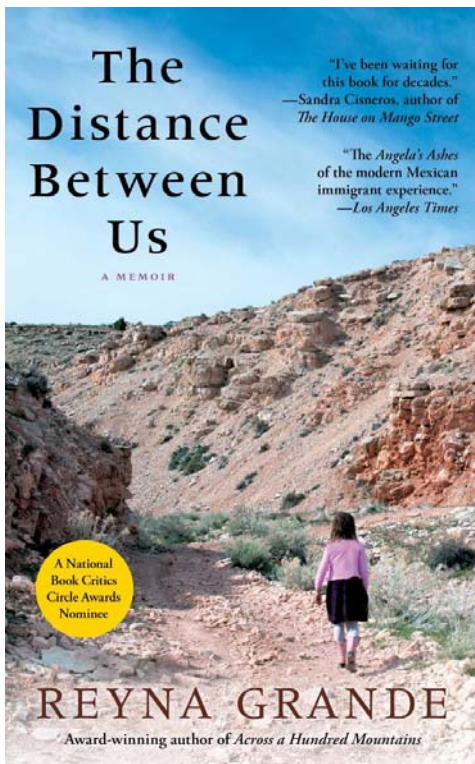

The City of Hagerstown is partnering with the Maryland State Arts Council, Washington County Arts Council, Washington County Museum of Fine Arts, the Valley Art Association and the Barbara Ingram School for the Arts to bring public sculpture to our community. Local sculptor, Paul Rhymer, has been hired to create a bronze sculpture for placement in the lake at Hagerstown's City Park. The sculpture will be life size and be located just off shore in the lake to ensure maximum visibility from the lake walkway system. The sculpture is called "The Fishing Lesson."

City Park is iconic for parents taking their children to feed the fish. The sculpture not only mirrors the teaching relationship of parent and child, but also subtly educates about the chain of life and the importance of teaching self-sufficiency.

### War of 1812 Cavalry Jacket

Please join us and invited dignitaries at a reception for the unveiling and welcome home of our treasured War of 1812 relic, the cavalry jacket of Sgt. Jacob Huyett, in time for its 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary at the Battle of North Point in 1814, on Friday, September 5, 2014, at the Miller House Museum, 135 West Washington Street, Hagerstown, MD, from 5 to 7 p.m.

Those invited include Governor Martin O'Malley and Lt. Governor Anthony Brown, officials from the Maryland War of 1812 Bicentennial Commission, descendants of the owner of jacket and local county and city officials. A presentation on the history of the jacket and its owner will be made by John Gladhill, one of the descendants.

There will also be a small exhibit of other Washington County artifacts related to the War of 1812.

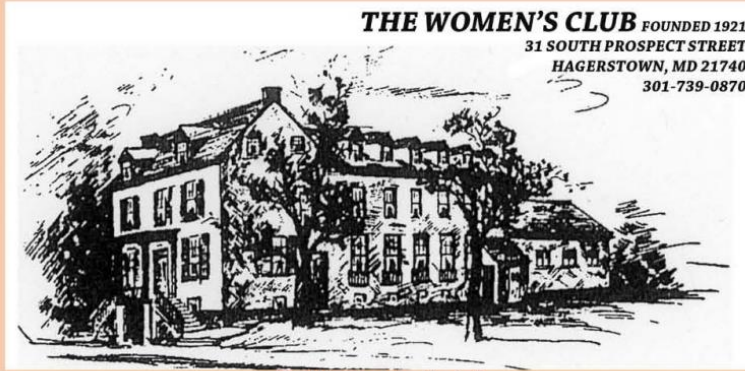
