

The City of Hagerstown is working with community partners and taking innovative approaches to enhance the Arts & Entertainment District and the Main Street area. Engine Room Art Space, a new cooperative art gallery located at 36 North Potomac Street, provides a unique venue for emerging artists to display their work while offering live-work space for local artists. Operated and managed by artists living in the upper-floor lofts, the gallery invites guests to experience new perspectives and artistic expressions in creative ways.

Engine Room Art Space is a place for the community to exchange ideas and form new perspectives of what art can be and what art does. The gallery welcomes local emerging artists to showcase art that presents challenging ideas or processes, serving as a platform for artists of oustanding talent and quality. It is a positive space for people to talk, make connections, get inspired, learn and gain experience. Engine Room Art Space is supported by The Studios on NoPo resident artists and is a program of Main Street Hagerstown presented by the City of Hagerstown's Department of Community & Economic Development.

The development of Engine Room Art Space was supported by instrumental community partners, including the Barbara Ingram School for the Arts Foundation and Citi. The City of Hagerstown partnered with the BISFA Foundation to apply for a grant to support an enhanced build-out of the gallery through the Citi Foundation. The grant was awarded at a funding level of \$50,000. In addition, Citi volunteers participated by painting the interior of the art gallery.


The Maryland Theatre Matt Maher in Concert








Joe Bonamassa All-acoustic Performance Maryland Theatre January 8, 2016 * 8:00pm
