The Washington County Arts Council, Inc. invites local artists working in any medium to submit their best new works for WCAC's "Annual Community Art Show: The Best Local Art of 2019." The juried community art exhibit will run from December 5, 2019 through January 7, 2020 with an opening reception on Thursday, December 5, 2019 from 5pm to 7pm.

About the Jurors:

Mark Youngblood

Mark Youngblood has been a photography teacher at Barbara Ingram School for the Arts as an Artist in Residence since the opening of the school in 2009. Mr. Youngblood is the owner of Youngblood Studios and has been a professional photographer for over 30 years. Mr. Youngblood attended Hagerstown Community College and then Shepherd University. Mr. Youngblood holds memberships in several professional photography organizations, including being named commercial and portrait photographer of the year in the state of Maryland.

Teresa Roberts

Dr. Teresa Roberts earned a BA in Fine Arts from Macalester College, an Interdisciplinary MEd in the visual arts and education from Frostburg State University, and a PhD in Art Education from The Ohio State University. Dr. Roberts taught visual arts in Maryland public secondary schools for 25 years including 9 years at Barbara Ingram School for the Arts in Hagerstown. Dr. Roberts has taught studio art, art appreciation, and art education courses at Frostburg State University, Allegany College, The Ohio State University and the Wexner Center for the Arts. Dr. Roberts has exhibited in a variety of locations throughout the country and has won scholarships and awards for her work.

Entry Guidelines:

Artists are encouraged to submit up to three entries. No works previously shown at WCAC will be considered.

Images must be submitted in a jpg format and files should be labeled: "Last Name_First Name_Title of Work." .jpg images should be as close to 1024 pixels x 768 pixels as possible with a resolution between 72ppi and 240ppi (pixels per inch). File size should be at least 1,100KB (1.1MB) and less than 2,500KB (2.5MB).

Artists who would like to have the CDs returned should include a stamped, self-addressed return envelope.

All digital entries must be submitted by October 26th, 2019. Artists will be notified of selection by November 9th, 2019.

Liability:

Once received by WCAC, all original artwork will be insured for 70% of its retail value as indicated on the provided inventory list until it has been sold or returned to the artist.

WCAC is not responsible for damage resulting from poor workmanship, defects or lack of quality control by the artist.

Conditions:

If selected, hanging works should be properly wired with eye hooks placed approximately 1/3 from the top of the work and framing wire of appropriate weight should be used. No saw tooth hangers, please. See attached Hanging Specifications document. All work must be labeled on the back with artist name, title, and price.

All work must be available for sale. WCAC, a non-profit agency, retains a 30% commission on all works sold during the exhibit.

WCAC will not exhibit any work that is presented in an unprofessional manner and reserves the right of final review on all work once it has been delivered.

Work cannot be withdrawn before the end of the exhibit.

Delivery and Pick Up:

Accepted work must be delivered to the gallery on November 30th, December 3rd or December 4th, 2019.

Exhibited work must be picked up on Tuesday, January 7th, 2020 between 3pm and 5pm.
