

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Submit your original artwork depicting an animal as the subject. An animal must take visual precedence in the composition. This year we are allowing fantasy animals. An animal must be a recognizable component, i.e., the "Pegasus" is a winged horse. The quality of the work will take precedence over the subject.

Any original representational two dimensional work in oil, pastel acrylic, watercolor, ink, pencil, or scratch board, and wall-mounted sculpture relief or in the round under 40 lbs will be considered. No photography, prints, or digital art will be accepted.

Framed dimensions for each entry must not exceed 28 x 34 inches. Work must not infringe on any copyright.

Acceptance notification - March 25th.

Artists will be notified by email of their accepted work. Notification by mail only if artist includes a self-addressed stamped postcard with entry.

Work must be HAND DELIVERED to the Schuler School any time after notification of acceptance. Work must be READY TO HANG and labeled with name, title, and price.

JPEG files should be a minimum size of 1MB, maximum 3MB, @ 300 dpi . Email or Disks should be labeled with the Artist's name, email address, and the name "Animal Show" in the subject line. The file name of each entry must correspond to the entry form with artist's name, title, and the letters A,B, or C for example, HansGuerin-Duck-A.jpg. Entries must be postmarked no later than March 23 2019.
